



Austrian eID so far – key characteristics

- Gvnmt. identity base (Population Register), but
 - open to public and private sector credential providers
 - open to public and private sector relying parties
 - LoA "high" (eIDAS definition)
- Voluntary system
 - Citizen may activate credentials she has (health insurance card, (bank cards), mobile phone, CA's smart cards)
- Free of charge for

A-SI

- relying parties (both private sector and public sector)
- citizens (health insurance card or mobile phone)

Austrian Citizen Card - an Overview

- Launched 2003, mass-rollouts from 2005
- Defines functions, not the technology
 - Identification, sector-specific to enhance privacy
 - Qualified signatures, for written form
 - Electronic mandates, representation
- Technology-neutral approach allowed for different implementations
 - Smartcards and mobile from 2005

– Foreign eID recognised from 2008





AT Mobile Signature: The Basics

- Follows a server-based approach
 - Crypto-keys kept at a central server (HSM)
 - No changes in mobile phone or SIM
 - 2-factor authent. (knowledge and possession)
 - SMS-OTP or QR-Code (Smartphone App)
- Qualified Signature-Creation Device (QSCD)
 Certified by notified body (Signature-Directive / eIDAS)
- Service operated by a trust service provider for gualified certificates





Lessons learned


Smartcard eID

A-5

- Satisfactory business users take-up
- But quite limited take-up by citizens
- Mobile signat. clear preference by citizens
 - 2014/15/16: 15/10/24 times higher mobile ID activation to health card activation
 - Under comparable conditions like free of charge
- Ease of use and easy activation essential







Next steps

- A-ᢒſ

- E-ID related laws amended due eIDAS
 - Name change "Citizen Card" => "E-ID"
 - Architecture changes with
 - Move from "middleware" to "central deployment"
 - Reinforcement of remote-signature concept
 - Changes in registration and issuance
- eIDAS notification at LoA high in progress
