

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Penang Weather

Penang enjoys a year-round tropical rainforest climate where it is warm and sunny all year round, with plentiful rainfall due to its geographical location and the monsoon climate. It is usually warmest in the months of January and February during the period of Chinese New Year, and rainy during the southwest monsoon from April to September. The climate is very much dictated by the surrounding sea and the wind system. The average temperature is above 30°C in the day and above 25°C at night. The weather in Penang is suitable for strolls or cycling around the city, whether day or night.

Campus

Please be advised that the campus is hilly, and it is advisable to bring proper shoes for walking especially for the campus tour and visit to CEMACS (Centre for Marine and Coastal Studies) – located in Penang National Park, 1 hour bus ride from USM to the jetty and 20 minutes boat ride to reach the centre.

Centre for Marine and Coastal Studies (CEMACS)

Participant will visit to CEMACS on the 29th February 2024. **CEMACS** is located at Teluk Aling the northwest coast of Penang Island in the Penang National Park. The centre is served by a number of core academics working in collaboration with research associates identified from other teaching schools as well as from outside the University. The centre's international associates include those from Canada, Australia, USA, UK, Japan, Cambodia, Indonesia, India, Iran, Australia, China, Singapore, Vietnam and Denmark. Associates of **CEMACS** are provided with the direct access to the centre's considerable research and training facilities. Presently, research and training conducted at the centre is focused on biodiversity and conservation of marine ecosystems, coastal forest ecosystems, mariculture and marine mammal ecology (dugong and dolphin).
